

## Find the Red Flags - Answer Key



Note the icon that appears next to the email address. The real Xfinity email uses the company logo as their image.




The fake one is using a strange red, white and yellow, black icon. NOT the official Xfinity logo.

The From section lists Xfinity.com in quotation marks. Following that link is the actual email address used—Application.Help@maryland.gov

The rest of the email looks pretty official. Most of the links have been copied

from an actual Comcast email coding. However, the button that stands out

most is in the same color as the word declined, is large and it links to a garbage webpage. Originally this link took you to a login screen that was very similar looking to the real Comcast login page. Once you enter your personal username and password, the fraudsters

will capture your information. If you enter your banking account information, they will have that captured as well.
